

**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING  
FRAUDULENT TREMCO INCORPORATED CHECKS**

It has recently come to our attention that a number of individuals throughout the United States may be receiving mailings containing forged and fraudulent checks bearing the name and address of Tremco Incorporated. In at least one instance that we are aware of, the check was sent with a letter advising the recipient that she had been randomly chosen to receive a cash prize of \$65,000. The sweepstakes winnings, like the checks, are not legitimate; the mailing appears to be part of a sophisticated “fake check” scam designed to trick the recipient into wiring money to the scammer.

If you have received an unsolicited check that bears the Tremco name please be advised that it is not a genuine Tremco Incorporated check and it will not be honored by Tremco’s bank. Tremco is not affiliated with any lotteries, sweepstakes or other promotional give-away programs directed at individual consumers. Do not provide the sender of such a check any money or personal information (e.g., bank account, credit card or social security numbers). Please note that this matter does not affect vendors, service-providers, and others who receive validly-issued Tremco Incorporated checks in payment for goods and services provided to Tremco. All such checks will continue to be honored in the ordinary course. This notice relates only to checks bearing the Tremco name that are received with unsolicited mailings to individual consumers.
